Children - 15 months - 18 years National Immunization Schedule 2024

When	Vaccine	What is it
16-24 months	Diphtheria, Pertussis & Tetanus (DPT) booster-1	Diphtheria, Pertussis (whooping cough), Tetanus Vaccine
16-24 months	MR 2nd dose	Measles Rubella Vaccine
16-24 months	OPV Booster	Orally administered Polio Vaccine
16-24 months	JE-2	Japanese Encephalitis Vaccine
16-18 months. Then subsequently one dose every 6 months up to the age of 5 years.	Vitamin A (2nd to 9th dose)	Vitamin A Supplement
5-6 Years	DPT Booster-2	Diphtheria, Pertussis (whooping cough), Tetanus Vaccine
10 years & 16 years	Td	Tetanus and Adult Diphtheria

Based on Doctor's advice	Typhoid Vaccine	Helps prevent Typhoid fever
Based on Doctor's advice	Influenza Vaccine	Protects against Flu
Based on Doctor's advice	Meningococcal disease	Helps prevent meningococcal disease
Based on Doctor's advice	Varicella	Protects against Chickenpox
Based on Doctor's advice	Mumps	Usually part of Measles and Rubella vaccine as MMR vaccine - to prevent Mumps
Based on Doctor's advice	Hepatitis A	Protects against Hepatitis A
Based on Doctor's advice	HPV Vaccine	Protects against Human Papillomavirus
